- 1. Work in the Local Church.
 - How has he/she demonstrated leadership and dedicated service in the local church? How has he/she lived and articulated the Christian faith at home and at church?
- 2. Work in the Community.
 - How has his/her faith and committed service been at work in the community? Has the person reached out in mission?
- 3. Work beyond the Local Community.
 - How has her/his faith and service been at work ecumenically, in the Conference, Jurisdiction, or General Church.
